



Race SuperSeries Rnd #7 – Testing & Qualifying

Race SuperSeries Rnd #7 took place on September 27, 28 & 29th. The weather was not the greatest and the temperatures were much cooler. Friday practice was at least dry and I was able to have 5 test sessions and posted my best time of 1:15.130sec for the day during my second outing.

Saturday was overcast and calling for rain. I was not able to get back down into the 1:15 sec range and had a scare when my front wheel slid out on me coming around the last corner. The bike slid a good foot before I was able to regain traction by using my knee to push the bike back up. The bike gave me a headshake in protest but I'll take that any day over crashing. I was now worried about the condition of the front tire if I slid so bad but it was only after the session that I found out what had happened. It seems a snake had decided to cross the track and it was my front tires sliding over the snake that caused my front end to wash out. Let's just say I fared better than the snake.

The afternoon heat races were a bit of a disaster. The first up was the Middleweight Sportsman class. I had an excellent start but then just seemed to keep dropping back. And then on the last lap, one rider almost hit me from behind going into the last corner before the back straight and then proceeded to try and run me off the track. I was on the rumble trips before I had to put out my elbow and start leaning into the rider because I was not going to allow him to put me into the grass. This killed my drive and I lost the position but tried hard to regain it before the front straight. Unfortunately I tried a little too hard and couldn't make the last turn and had to run off into the grass. I kept the bike up and rejoined the race but only after loosing another position. Needless to say I was upset!! But a lesson learned was to keep a cool head otherwise you will only negatively impact yourself. The SV-CUP heat race ended up being cancelled due to bad weather.

Race SuperSeries Rnd #7 - Race Results

Sunday ended up being cool but at least it was no longer raining. I decided not to go out for the Middleweight test session, which was the first session of the morning. The track was still wet and I would accomplish nothing by going out. I posted a 1:18.332sec for my SV-CUP test session later that morning but clearly wasn't in the mood for racing since this was over 3 seconds slower than my fastest time posted on Friday.

The SV-CUP race was first up and I had a great start but didn't really gain or loose any ground. I ended up placing 13th with a best lap of 1:16.007sec. Although this was not a stellar performance, it was enough to place me 9th overall in points for the season and my goal was a top 10 so I was happy with the end result.

The Middleweight race was my last race of the season and it didn't disappoint. I raced hard and gained several positions finishing ahead of people that are usually faster. I ended up placing 10th in the race and posting a laptime of 1:15.164sec, which was close to my personal best. The big surprise was that by finishing 10th, it also placed me tied for 10th in overall points for the season. This was completely unexpected as I'm racing against Pros and some people with faster bikes than mine. Also keep in mind that I placed second last during the first round of the season in this class.

2008 Race SuperSeries Summary

Overall I'm happy with the 2008 season considering the two crashes I had in 2007 with one of them resulting in a broken clavicle. I worked hard at the starting of the season on changing my riding style so I'd be safer but I still needed to get my confidence back. I was much slower in the beginning but turned a corner midway through the season and started to get faster. People I race with were commenting they can see that I'm riding much better and that I seem to have more confidence. I guess I had some personal demons I needed to deal with and it is true that you can teach an old dog new tricks.

Meeting my goal of a top 10 in overall points standing for the season was also very satisfying. It is good to have reasonable goals in whatever you do and it's even better when you meet or exceed them. My goal for 2009 is a finish in the top 5 for the season. It is a lofty goal considering the excellent caliber of riders I'm currently racing with and of course there are always new young whippersnappers who seem to be fast right from the start.
